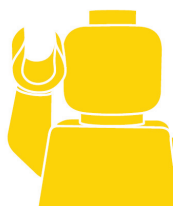

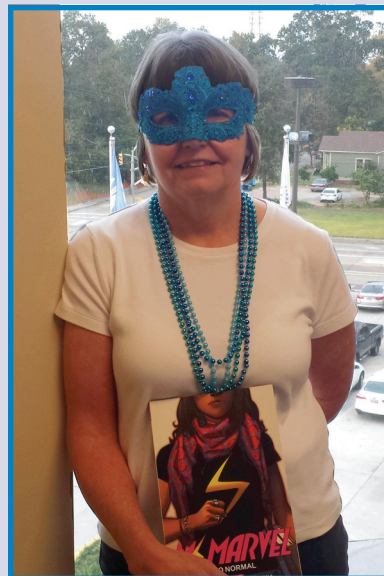
Notes from the Library Director

It is very expensive to staff and maintain facilities. Currently, we own 130,000 square feet of buildings, plus parking lots and grounds. That is 2.9 acres of space to light, cool and staff. We strive to provide the best at the lowest cost, always with an eye to the future growth of Lafayette Parish and its residents' needs. If we didn't get your vote in November, feel free to let us know what we can do to earn it next time.
