Sign up for both book clubs at your local library branch or online at lafayettepubliclibrary.beanstack.org. Now you can log books read to your child as well as activity challenges throughout their literacy journey, and yes, the same book can be counted every time you read it to your child! Once your child reads 100 books with your help, and completes the "Explore" challenge, share the great news with your librarian! Then, keep reading and complete our fun early literacy challenges, you can even pick up another log to track more books! At the end of the year, we will host an annual reading celebration to recognize all the participants.

EXPLORE

- Visit our Facebook page and watch Digital Storytime at 10:00 AM on Mondays & Wednesdays
- Explore other titles by the author of your child's favorite book.
- Visit our YouTube page and watch the Storytime Jr. Playlist.

READ

- Let your child turn the pages in the book as you read together.
- Look for the first letter in your child's name together as you read a book.
- Let your child "read" their favorite book to you.

TALK

- Help your child retell a story you read together.
- While going through the alphabet, talk about the shapes that make up each letter.
- Go for a nature walk and talk about what you see, hear, and even smell.

PLAY

- Play peek-a-boo to reinforce object permanence.
- Track bubbles as they float by and pop them!
- Act out the words of a book or song.

SING

- Sing nursery rhymes together.
- Make up your own movements and motions to your favorite songs.
- Bounce your child in your lap to the rhythm of their favorite song.

WRITE

- Have your child create a card for someone and sign their own name.
- Ask your child to explain what they have written or scribbled down.
- Have your child practice writing their name.
